How We Work

MSH works with its partners, large and small, around the world to:

- define their highest-priority health problems, and explore and establish practical, locally appropriate solutions to those problems;
- develop a strong workforce by building the capacity to lead, manage, and sustain health services;
- advocate for changes in health policy and financing to remove barriers to access to health care;
- design and implement effective management systems for health services.

What We Do

Since 1971, MSH has worked with its partners in more than 140 countries to improve health services. MSH helps public and private organizations throughout the world to effectively manage people, medicines, money, and information. Clients include ministries of health and nongovernmental, faith-based, and civil-society organizations that manage and deliver health services in developing countries.

Areas of Expertise

MSH is organized around three areas of expertise:

Leadership, Governance, and Management

Provides services and innovative learning programs for leadership development, health information systems, human capacity development, quality improvement, health policy reform and financing, financial management, and health systems development and management.

Pharmaceutical Management Provides technical assistance, research, and training related to pharmaceutical sector studies, policy and options analysis, procurement and inventory management, pharmaceutical management information systems, laboratory policy and systems, rational use of medicines, regulation, and product quality.

Health Services Focuses on the management of effective health services and proven curative and preventive interventions in maternal, newborn, and child health; family planning/reproductive health; HIV & AIDS, tuberculosis, malaria, avian influenza, and other communicable diseases. Provides assistance to scale up the delivery of these services.

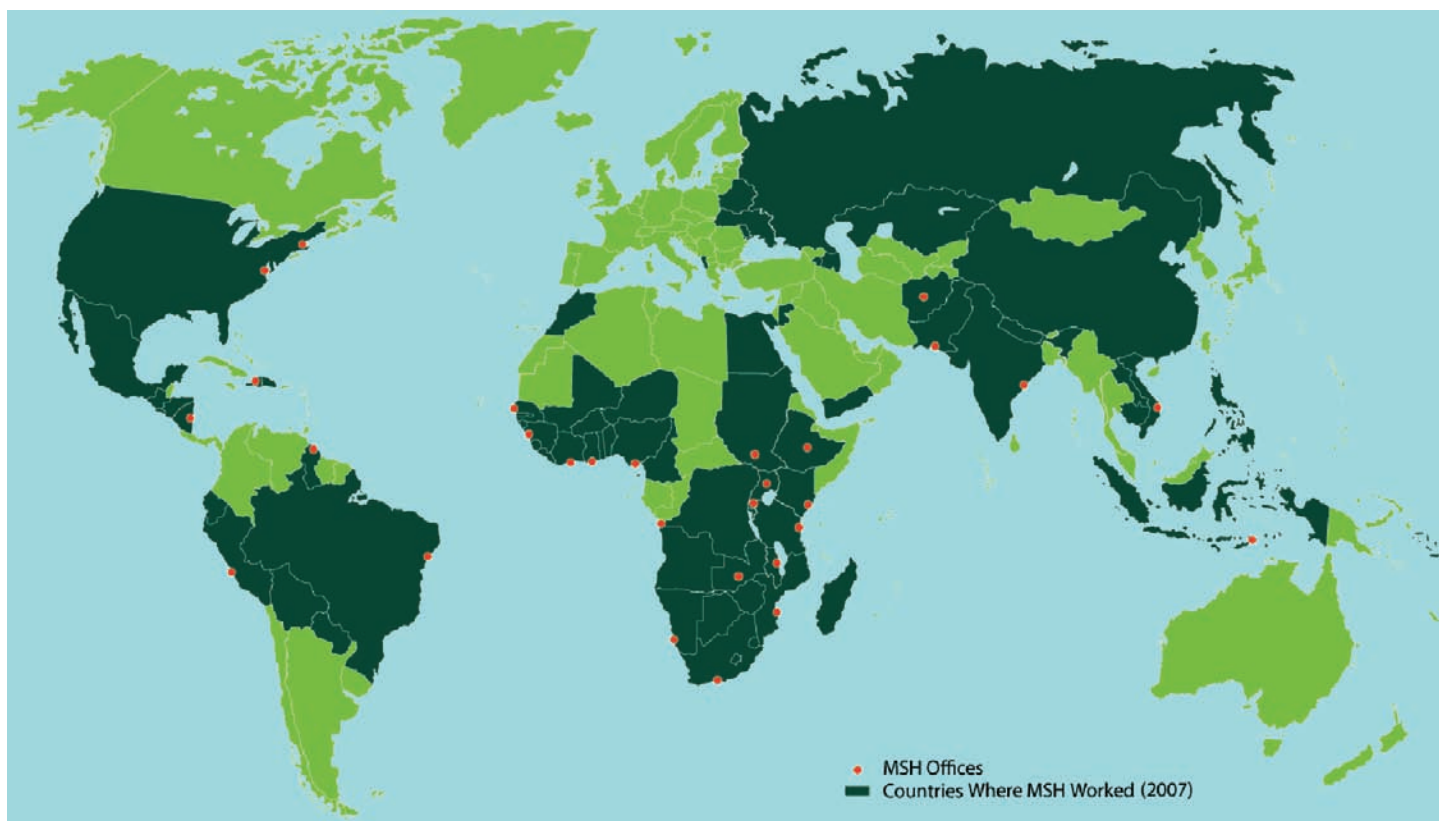
